SUBMISSION DEADLINES

The scholarship submission process will begin March 4, 2019. Completed scholarship submissions must be received by May 31, 2019.

- Candidates selected for interviews will be contacted by June 4, 2019.
- Scholarship recipients will be announced in August 2019.
- Scholarship recipients will be honored at a special luncheon at The Americana at Brand in Glendale, CA in Summer 2019.

The scholarship will be awarded in its totality directly to the school that the scholar has chosen to attend.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

Students are eligible to be considered for The Spirit of American Youth scholarship if they:

- Have demonstrated leadership abilities through participation in community service, extracurricular, or other activities
- Are a high school senior currently residing in or attending a public or private high school in the San Gabriel Valley or San Fernando Valley, including, but not limited to, the following communities: Glendale, Montrose, Pasadena, Arcadia, Eagle Rock, La Canada, La Crescenta, Los Feliz, San Marino, Toluca Lake, Burbank, Studio City, Sherman Oaks, and Encino
- Have attained a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 (weighted grades may be used)
- Will be enrolling for the first time at a United States accredited college or university as a full-time, degree-seeking, first-year student in the Fall 2019
- Are a citizen, national or legal permanent resident of the United States
- Have completed and submitted all required forms by the deadline (forms available at AmericanaAtBrand.com)

Applications will be evaluated based on:

- Determination to succeed and future goals and plans to achieve them
- How students intend to invest back into their communities to help create a better existence for future generations

CURRENT AND PAST ASSOCIATES AND CONTRACT PARTNERS OF CARUSO AND THEIR RELATIVES ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION IN THE SPIRIT OF AMERICAN YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP.

HOW TO APPLY?

The scholarship application includes the following three required forms:

- The Spirit of American Youth Scholarship Application
- Teacher/Counselor Recommendation Form (to be submitted in a sealed envelope with Application). These Forms can be downloaded from The Americana at Brand website at AmericanaAtBrand.com.
- The Spirit of American Youth Essay

The Spirit of American Youth Essay must be:

- Within the defined word limits
- Double spaced; typed
- Font Size and Style: Arial 12
- In English
- Original work
